Retire at your hotel in Gauteng.

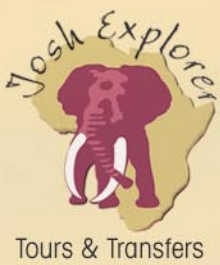
### **DAY 4**

It will be exchange of culture to one person to another, painting hurts it will also be the most thing that will impress you.

Men join Ndebele men under the Marula tree settling some dispute or issues within the community whereas the women busy doing other things which women are known for (chores) e.g. beading, painting and flooring etc.
