Morning leave Ezwulwini valley via Merlkerns candle factory pass the industrial Matsapa-Manzini to Kwazulu-Natal province in South Africa. Today you will enjoy your evening with Zulu people in their area, Experience the Zulu culture, listen and dance according to the African at Dumazulu cultural village.

Overnight at Dumazulu cultural village or similar.

DAY 6

Saint Lucia

It is a nature lover's paradise with great scenery. St. Lucia is an island that is plucked from the South Pacific and set down in the Caribbean.

It has a great variety of plant and animal life. Orchids and exotic plants grow wild in the rain forest and roadsides are covered with many tropical flowers. This is the place of different and colorfully-plumed tropical birds abound, including the endangered species like the indigenous St. Lucia parrot, Hummingbird and the Oriole.
