



LIMPOPO GET AWAY TOUR

DAY 1

Pretoria Tour:

Depart from Johannesburg for an excursion of Pretoria, the country's administrative capital, visiting all the historical sites and places of interest.

The highlights are the Voortrekker Monument, Kruger House, Church Square, the City Hall, State Theatre/ Opera House and the Union Buildings.

To experience some culture in Polokwane we visit the following places.

Bakone Malapa Open Air Museum

It is regarded as a living museum, and it is one of the several museum and national monuments that bear testimony to South Africa's people. It is where the tribesmen practice long- standing traditions of Africa's people.

The cultural village includes two homesteads or lapas that display and explain fire making, maize grinding and beer brewing as they would carried out years ago.

Polokwane Museum

It is based in a beautiful Late Victorian shop building and was built in 1906 by a German immigrant and sold in 1920 and he named the shop Irish house. The building was restored to its former glory in 1986 when it became a museum.

Themes depicting the different cultures of the different peoples of the Limpopo can be viewed.

Overnight at Magoebaskloof or similar.



DAY 2

Tzaneen and Modjadji

Visit the tea plantations and have a different taste of South African tea, tea tour at Sapkoe. Tea estate, taste the only South African Rooibos tea. The Tzaneen museum has fascinating stories of the local people around the town.

Visit the Modjadji Cycad forest. Tour around the rain making Queen's village and have lunch with the Queen due to appointment and her presence.

Overnight at Magoebaskloof or similar.

DAY 3

Venda Area

Early in the morning you visit the Tsonga textile and also join the villagers at Mukondeni in making pottery out of clay. Visit the Phuxanani youth centre.

Overnight at Makhado hotels or similar.

DAY 4

Venda – Kruger National Park

Morning depart the land of legend and myth (Venda) to Kruger park through the former capital of the Republic of Venda Thohoyandou.

Overnight in a camp in the animal kingdom.

DAY 5

Kruger National Park

Truly the flagship of South African National Parks, Kruger is home to an impressive number species: 336 trees, 49 fish, 34 amphibians, 114 reptiles, 507 birds and 147 mammals.

Man's interaction with the lowveld environment over many centuries from bushman rock paintings to majestic archaeological sight like Masorini and Thulamela, is evident in the Kruger National park.

Drive to the South of the park.

Overnight at Hazyview or similar.



DAY 7

Panoramic Route

Visit the most exciting and spectacular views of the Mpumalanga province, visit the God's window, Mac-Mac fall, long Tom Pass, Pilgrims rest and the Three Rondevals.

Thrill the Shagaan cultural village and their well, tuned voices and energetic dance around an open fire you will also have a chance to taste the mopane worms (Mashondza)

Overnight at Hazyview or similar.

DAY 8

Hazyview

Early in the morning after breakfast you leave to Gauteng, have lunch on the way. Check in Sandton hotels or similar. Evening at leisure or you can go to Moyo's restaurant.

DAY 9

The city of Gold

Morning after breakfast departs at Hazyview to Johannesburg hotels or a drop off at the Airport. Arriving in the city of gold you will visit Soweto a place where history lies or Apartheid museum.

Overnight at Sandton or similar.
