CLASSIC KALEIDOSCOPE

Our classic roundtrip combines the rich coastal diversity in and around Swakopmud with the attractions of the Central and Northern of region of scenic Damaraland and the wildlife kingdom of Etosha National Park.

DAY 1

Travel through the historical town of Okahandja to the coastal town of Swakopmud prior to arrival in Swakopmud we visit moon valley and the Namibia's most celebrated plant, the ancient Welmitstchia Mirabilis, found on the vast gravel plains.

Overnight at Swakopmud Hansa Hotel or similar.

DAY 2

Full day at leisure to explore the historic town of Swakopmud. Swakopmud has a multitude of guided and adventure activities to offer.

Overnight at Hansa Hotel or similar.

DAY 3

Departing Swakopmud we travel Northwards past a number of shallow ponds used for salt production and farming oysters, following the coastline to Henties Bay. We travel onwards towards the Cape Cross Seal Reserve, boasting over 100 000 Cape Fur Seals and then head inland to Damaraland with its rugged landscapes, Sparse population and great mountains.

Overnight at Damaraland Twyfelfontein lodge or similar.



DAY 4

Twyfelfontein, means “doubtful spring” here we find slopes strewn with boulders, all dotted with thousand of engravings and some ancient paintings. A visit will also be made to the Petrified Forest. Proceed via Khorixas, the old administrative capital of Namibia and on to the town of Outjo.

Overnight at Outjo Etosha Garden Hotel or similar.

DAY 5

Enter the world famous Etosha National Park, where a full day of game driving is enjoyed as we head east. Herbivores such as Zebra, Elephant, Giraffe, Eland, Blue Wildebeest, Gemsbok, Springbok, Kudu and steenbok abound. Among the rarer species, Black Rhino and White Rhino (recently reintroduced) are sometimes seen.

Hundred of birds species have been recorded, including many migrants during the summer period. Larger felines are also found such as the Lion, Leopard, Cheetah and Caracal, with Hyenas, Cape Fox and Black Backed Jackal seen during the early mornings and late evenings. Exit the National Park and proceed to a private lodge situated outside the National Park.

Overnight at Etosha National Park or similar

DAY 6

We return to the National Park for a morning game drive before proceeding via the town of Tsumeb to Otavi, situated in a fertile farming area and onto our lodge.

Overnight at Otavi Khorab Lodge or similar.

DAY 7

Today we head South via Otjiwarongo and Okahadja stopping here to visit the well known Karango wood carvers market. We return to Windhoek where the tour ends with a transfer to your hotel.
